PRESIDENT: We still have before us the Lewis amendment to the committee amendments. Chair recognizes Senator Marsh and then Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, I too support the Lewis amendment and would like to urge us to adopt this and move it on.

PRESIDENT: Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I doubt if there's anyone here that has more of these people in their district than I have. They have their own building up there that they live in right in my district and it was the urging of these retired people, retired teachers that I had the amendment passed here and placed on the ballot which was passed last election and I think Senator Lewis has done a memorable job, a great job in getting this bill as far as it has. Retirement committee has studied it ever since we came into session I believe and I think we should adopt the amendment that Senator Lewis has and move this bill on as far as we can.

PRESIDENT: Now is there any further discussion of the Lewis amendment to the committee amendment? No further discussion, Senator Lewis you may close on your amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I'll make it brief. I think we ought to move it and act just like we're going on with it and I want to move this bill as far as I can move it and if we're still here for Final Reading, let's go with it. I move we adopt the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Try it by a voice vote. All those in favor of adopting the Lewis amendment say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the Lewis amendment is adopted. Now we have, that's, that's the amendment to the committee amendments. Now we have the committee amendments to adopt. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I move we adopt the committee amendments as amended.

PRESIDENT: Now is there any further discussion of the committee amendments as amended? Any discussion? Question is, then I'll try a voice vote again, the question is, shall the committee amendments as amended by the Lewis amendment be adopted? All those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the committee amendments are adopted. Now we're back to the bill as amended. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I move that we advance it to Select File.

PRESIDENT: Now you've heard the motion to advance LB 445. That's the bill as amended by the committee amendments. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, does the motion to bracket take priority over a motion to advance?

PRESIDENT: You want to move now to bracket the bill? Your motion is in order to bracket the bill if you want to and if you get enough votes, fine and dandy. It will take 25 votes the chair would feel to bracket the bill.
