PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Reads vote. 45 ayes, no nays, 4 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention, please. The Final Reading of LB 145 and before the Clerk begins that the chair would like to announce that seated in the north balcony today we are privileged to have 60 youth members of the Greater Omaha Association for Retarded Children. They have 12 adults that are accompanying them and their instructor or the person in charge of the group is Miss Judy Pierce and we're delighted to have you today for observation here of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature. We hope you enjoy your visit to the Capitol City and also to this magnificent building. Once again we'll go back to Final Reading, please the Final Reading of LB 145. Clerk will read the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention, please. The Final Reading of LB 148.

CLERK: Reads bill.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Reads vote. 42 ayes, no nays, 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. We next turn our attention to the Final Reading of LB 193. Senator Kelly, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR KELLY: Voting aye on 148.

PRESIDENT: Too late, not after the vote has been announced. Senator Carpenter, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Why did we pass over 179? There's no A-bill to it, there's no intention of having an A-bill. There's no appropriation in the appropriation bill, there's no A-bill carrying an appropriation. There won't be an A-bill. All this is is a gift to the State of Nebraska.

PRESIDENT: The chair does not have an explanation, Senator Carpenter other than that I have a list of bills here and that's the only reason for that. Do you want to direct your question to someone else?

SENATOR CARPENTER: The chairman of the budget committee or somebody.
