SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 481 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion now to advance LB 481 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Does 547 have amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 547.

PRESIDENT: Was that a motion to advance the bill, I'm sorry, I was distracted for the moment. Are there amendments?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move to adopt the amendments.

PRESIDENT: Question is, shall the amendments to 547 be adopted? All those in favor of the motion please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, there are pending some amendments by Senator Carpenter which we can't...

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Cavanaugh, we'll have to advance the bill and then we have Senator Carpenter's amendments and he'll have to move to bring it back.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 547 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to advance the bill. All those in favor of advancing 547 please say aye, those opposed say no. LB 547 is advanced. Now Senator Carpenter, do you want to make your motion? Why don't you stand by just a second here and we'll take 445 and move it on and we'll come back to you. Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I'd like to delay any action on Select File on 445 today, if we could just pass over that until next time.

PRESIDENT: Fine, Senator Lewis is asking unanimous consent to pass over 445 on Select File. Are there any objections? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. Pass over the bill. We're back to 547 then Senator Carpenter.

CLERK: Okay now Mr. President, we have a motion to return LB 547 to Select File for specific amendment, signed Senator Carpenter. The specific amendment is to add the emergency clause.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced back.

PRESIDENT: Go ahead sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: It adds the emergency clause and it's necessary because in my judgment for, this bill has to do with the appropriations so that you can appropriate the money over a period of time rather than accumulate the money and have it all in your pocket on the day, the year in which it's appropriated. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter's motion is to return 547 to Select File for a specific amendment. That is to add the E clause. All those in favor of returning the bill for the specific amendment vote aye, all those opposed vote no.
