Well, I suppose it's redundant for the chair to remind the body that it still takes 25 votes to return a bill to Select File. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes on motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Bill is returned. Senator Carpenter, we'll take your motion now.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: No, we need the motion to put on the E clause, Senator. Motion to put on the E clause.

SENATOR CARPENTER: To move from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: No, we need the motion now to add the E clause.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Oh, we haven't done it. I move we add the emergency clause to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Motion is to add the emergency clause to 547 on Select File. All those in favor of adding the emergency clause please vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The E clause is added to 547.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill now be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter's motion now is to re-advance LB 547 as amended. All those in favor of re-advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill as amended is advanced. Okay, that finishes Select File. Do we have any motions on the desk to reconsider?

CLERK: Yes, we have a series of motions, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to read the reports first? Oh, okay. Fine.

CLERK: Reads reports.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, I would like to ask unanimous consent to take all three of these appointees up at the same time. There were no votes against any of these three men in the committee so I presume they are noncontroversial.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion?
