SPEAKER: The Chair wishes to state that Senator Chambers' motion is out of order, that he would have to move to reconsider because this legislative body has already moved to consider LB 259 so Senator Chambers' motion would have to be to reconsider our previous action.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now, Mr. President, that is the way I would like the motion to be framed.
