CLERK: I have a motion, Mr. President. We also have some reports.

PRESIDENT: Well, we'd like to bring the body to some order here, please, we actually still are on Final Reading but I know that we have a motion on the desk to recess..

CLERK: Reads reports.

PRESIDENT: Just a second, please. The chair would like to acknowledge the presence of a group from ENCOR. They are from Omaha, There are 18 members up there and I think their leader and they are in the north balcony and we're delighted to have you here today to watch the movements of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature. Now then, while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I am signing LB 259.

CLERK: Reads reports.

PRESIDENT: Just a second, please. Senator Kremer, for what purpose did you wish to be recognized? Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, only to remind the members of Public Works that there will be an Executive Session at 1:00 lest they forget.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: ...remind the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee that we have a public hearing in room 1009 starting at 12:45 today.

PRESIDENT: Very good. Senator Cal Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, point of personal privilege, please.

PRESIDENT: State your point, Senator.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Just a reminder that on April 29 Arbor Day will be celebrated at Nebraska City again. The First Annual Arbor Day awards will be made and I believe there are 17. The Governor will be there, Mr. Ed Cliff a former forestry associate will be there as a speaker and I'm sure that you will enjoy the day if you will but come down to river country and see Arbor Lodge once again. Thank you sir.

PRESIDENT: You bet. Senator Schmit, did you wish to be recognized for some reason? Is there any other business to come before the body? Read the motion, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move we adjourn until 10:00 a.m. on April 30. Signed, Senator Richendifer.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adjourn until 10:00 a.m. April 30. Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, we've capped the morning with a very fine experience here with these ladies coming here. I don't believe the mood of this Legislature would allow us to do justice to anyone's bills further this afternoon so I've made the motion that we adjourn until April 30 at 10:00 a.m.
