SPEAKER: Now we have, Senator Stahmer wishes to speak, then Senator Snyder, Kremer, Kelly, Maresh. Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: A Mr. President, first of all, before I respond to Senator Carpenter, if I would I'd like to ask permission if I could interrupt for one minute here and ask permission to have printed in the journal some amendments to LB 286, that I have previously sent up to the a, chair. If thats possible, if I'm not out of order now?

SENATOR STAHMER: Oh, all right excuse me. I'll bring that up later. I'd just like to respond to Senator Carpenter by saying theres one thing I'm not clear on Senator Carpenter, when your talking about not having the staff go out with the committees. Would that also include the budget committee because if it did I think that would be a mistake. If we under take fiscal study, I think certainly that ought to be able to go with us.

SENATOR CARPENTER: As I understand, the direction of Legislative Council, we turn all the staff over to the budget committee as chairman. You do what ever you want to with him and we told you and Mr. Gerdes, don't come back with any excuses, number 1, he didn't have enough money to hire those people if he wanted to, but we didn't put any ceiling on it. The only thing we did, we put a limit of 18 men. If thats not enough come back and talk, we'll try to do better if we aren't, but this belongs to your committee. Its your responsibility, for what ever they do.

SENATOR STAHMER: Well I would think we could dilute the studies too much by spreading our people too thin. I just want to make sure that the fiscal staff itself could go out with the budget committee, because I think this is an absolute essential.

SPEAKER: Now we have a motion to recess, its almost 12:00 and will the clerk read--

CLERK: I have one more study resolution, its introduced by Senator Keyes, where as the failure of (Read) Mr. President we have unanimous consent by Senator Fellman to insert in the Journal certain amendments to LB 358 and to 127.

SPEAKER: If theres no objections so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a unanimous consent request by Senator Stahmer to print amendments to the in the journal to LB 286.

SPEAKER: If theres no objections it will be so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, notice of the committee hearing, Agricultural has set LB 378 for Monday, May 7, signed Senator Schmidt chairman. Mr. President, your committee in Public works to whom is referred LB 87 and such may report the same the Legislatures recommendation be advanced to general file, as amended. Mr. President, we have a new bill LB 579, introduced by Senator Fellman, at the request of the Governor. A bill for making a reappropriations for the period of July 1, 73' to June 30, 74' for construction repair and improvement of State buildings as prescribed to define terms for site limits and conditions on the expenditure of funds, and to declare an emergency. Mr. President, Senator Wiltse, would like to bracket LB 238 on general file indefinitely.
