CLERK: 27 ayes, 4 nays, to go under call.

SPEAKER: House is under call. Senator Lewis voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Frank Lewis voting aye.

SPEAKER: Senator Lewis, you will have to retain your seat while the house is under call. All please record your presence. Have you all recorded your presence? Clerk will record. Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: I move the call be raised.

SPEAKER: Motion is made that the call be raised. All those in favor of raising the call, so indicate. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I'll ask for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER: Roll call vote has been requested. Clerk will record. How many to raise the call, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: 24 ayes, 11 nays to raise the call.

SPEAKER: Call is not raised, requires 25 votes. House is still under call. Proceed with the roll call vote. Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote.

SPEAKER: Excuse me, Mr. Clerk, Senator Moylan had an emergency telephone call and asked to be excused. No objections? So ordered.
