SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, I believe that Senator Moylan will vote for this bill so before the tally is announced, I'd like to wait until he returns.

SPEAKER: Well, house is under call, Senator, there will have to be a motion to raise the call before we can record the vote.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, then I'll just wait.

SPEAKER: Senator Dickinson. Senator Dickinson voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Dickinson voting aye.

(Start Belt #3)

SPEAKER: House is still under call. Senator Lewis, you'll have to take your seat, there can be no lobbying on the floor while under call. Senator Lewis. The Chair does not indicate that you were lobbying but you were wandering around. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, I move that the call be raised.

SPEAKER: Motion has been made that the call be raised. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, no nays to raise the call.

SPEAKER: Clerk will announce the vote. Just a moment. Just a minute, hold on. Mr. Clerk, what was that vote? Well, how did he vote.

CLERK: Senator Richendifer voting aye.

SPEAKER: Yes, we're on final reading and the vote has not been announced. Vote is accepted.

CLERK: Senator Moylan voting aye.

SPEAKER: Clerk will announce the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 21 nays, 2 not voting. No--1 not voting.

SPEAKER: Bill is passed. LB 477. Clerk will read.

CLERK: Engross Legislative Bill 477, introduced by Senator Schmit of the 23rd district for the Governor (read).
