CLERK: I have some committee reports Mr. President. (READ) signed Senator Cavanaugh.

SPEAKER: While the Legislature is in session, capable of transacting business, I'm about to sign and do sign LB 343, LB 477, LB 496 and LB 496A.

CLERK: That's all Mr. President, Oh, wait a minute, we have a resolution some where. Mr. President, we have a Legislative resolution #56, introduced by Senator Maresh, (READ) Referred to the Executive Board.

SPEAKER: Any new bills Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER: Anything further on your desk?

CLERK: Nothing.

SPEAKER: We're now ready to go to general file.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill on general file is LB 45. The title was read yesterday. The standing committee amendments were considered but not adopted. There have been a series of amendments to the standing committee amendments. There have been 2 by Senator Barnett, 1 by Senator Goodrich. There is presently pending another amendment by Senator Goodrich.

SPEAKER: What's the first amendment Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Senator Goodrich's amendment, it's an amendment to the committee amendment, pages 99 (READ) signed Senator Goodrich.

SPEAKER: Is Senator Goodrich here? Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I can handle that amendment if it's all right. The reason that that amendment is being made is for the previous first part of this legislative session, Senator Fowler introduced an insurance bill to raise it from 100 to 250 and this is complying with that Bill. LB 417.

SPEAKER: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS. I just want to be sure though that all your changing is the 100 to 250 because if I recall correctly this has always been the duty to report this.

SENATOR BARNETT: That's all that we've been informed that their changing Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Well when I heard the amendment, it didn't sound like that. It sounded as though they were taking, I'm wondering if your amending the right section of law. That's the thing that's bothering me.

SENATOR BARNETT: Ok, because I think what happened was that they Emery Burnett, changed the whole law, because I asked Senator Goodrich the same thing, I mean he, he printed the whole section for that one amendment. Where I thought
