**SENATOR CAVANAUGH:** Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 515.

**SPEAKER:** It has been moved that the amendments be adopted to LB 515. Is there any discussion? Is not, all those in favor, of the amendments, say aye, those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

**SENATOR CAVANAUGH:** The amendment of LB 515 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

**SPEAKER:** Is there any discussion as to the advancement of the bill? If not all those in favor of advancing the bill as amended, say aye, those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

**SENATOR CAVANAUGH:** Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 55.

**SPEAKER:** Any discussion. All those in favor of adopting the amendments to LB 55, say aye, those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

**SENATOR CAVANAUGH:** Mr. President, I move LB 55 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

**SPEAKER:** Is there any discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended say aye, those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

**CLERK:** Your committee (Read) signed Senator Cavanaugh.

**SPEAKER:** While the legislature is in session, capable of transacting business I'm about to sign and do sign the following bills, LB 121, LB 225, LB 399, LB 509, LB 540, LB 547, LB 372. There are some legislative confirmations Senator Whitney, are you ready at this time? Mr. Clerk do you know what page those are on?

**CLERK:** There on page 1439 of the Journal.

**SPEAKER:** Page 1439 of the Journal.

**CLERK:** (Reads Governors appointments) signed Raymond Whitney chairman.

**SPEAKER:** Senator Whitney.

**SENATOR WHITNEY:** Mr. President, members of the legislature, I'd like to ask unanimous consent for these 3 persons to be approved at the same time by the legislature. There is no controversy on any of these three persons. There are also some other men involved here. Did we want to take all of them at the same time?

**SPEAKER:** Why not?
