But it would be certain based upon the mechanics of what this body ordinarily does that if we allocate the twenty million dollars this year, we'd normally expect we'd do it for each continuing year from there on. It's not an obligation but we probably would do it. In view of the fact that there is additional information, I think this is a highly important subject, and I think many people are interested. I am sure everybody in this body is interested and many people out of this body, and as I understand, there will be additional information here by 2 o'clock. Is that so, Senator Marvel?

SPEAKER: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Do you expect to have additional information on this specific bill by 2 o'clock, insofar as money is concerned.

SENATOR MARVEL: We are going to talk...start at noon and talk. Yes, we can have some information on this but we are going to proceed basically on capital construction but also talk about other finances.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well then, Mr. President, I move we recess until 2 o'clock with the hope he will have additional information at that time.

SPEAKER: Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Senator Carpenter, if you would go along with us taking care of how we distribute the funds to start with and let my amendment go by the Board, I think that would...it has no relationship to the source of funds. If we could clean this up before we adjourn, I would appreciate that.

SPEAKER: Senator, I am all in favor of cleaning that up but we have a number, here, that want to speak and does it make that much difference to you.

SENATOR LEWIS: No, your logic has overwhelmed me. I am ready to go.

SPEAKER: All right. The motion is to recess until 2:00 P.M. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed no. The motion is carried. We will recess till 2:00 P.M.
