

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes. We, uh, uh, in--LB 259 includes the recommendations of the Governor for the implementation of this pay plan that's in this bill. That's the way I understand it.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well, Mr. President, I will not object to these two bills, I, I probably wouldn't object to any others, but I hope we'll get on these tax bills this afternoon because I think they're vitally important and I think the reasons are self evident. So I have no objection to consider these two ahead of the tax bill which has been set for today.

SPEAKER: Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: --say, Senator Carpenter, that it would be my feeling that there shouldn't be any major objection to this bill and that it should move expeditiously and shouldn't occupy that much time and it is an important bill.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Anything on the Clerk's desk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk reports (read) Move to introduce bill. (read)

SPEAKER: Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. Speaker, I would ask unanimous consent to hold this until 2:00 o'clock. There is obviously not 30 votes in here right now.

SPEAKER: So ordered. Ready for select file. Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, do you have that amendment? Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 454.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? All those in favor of adoption of the amendment say aye. Those opposed no. Amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Okay, Mr. President, we then have an amendment to add--a motion to amend the bill by Senator Goodrich. This bill was returned to select file for a E&R amendment.

SPEAKER: Technically, Senator, you have to suspend the rules or let the bill go forward and then bring it back with 25 votes. Do you want to let it go forward and then we'll do your motion or do you want to try it with 30 votes? Technically as far as I'm concerned but nevertheless it's the rule.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Let it go forward and come back then.

SPEAKER: Alright, then you'll re--you'll hold your motion until it gets--

SPEAKER: Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 454 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.
