

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Stull, back to you, sir.

SENATOR STULL: Members of the Legislature, I move that 312 be advanced to E & R as amended.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to advance LB 312 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill as amended is advanced. We now have 172.

CLERK: All right. Now, Mr. President, we have the E & R amendments to

PRESIDENT: Wait a minute. Senator Dickinson, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DICKINSON: Well, Mr. Speaker, if everyone in the room thoroughly understands the exact status of 312 now, I will not say another word. If anybody misunderstands it as I do, I wish the clerk would fill in the exact wording so we know exactly what amendments are now on it and what it says. I really don't believe we all agree on what it says.

PRESIDENT: I am not sure that I can help you, Senator Dickinson, but I will try. We adopted the E & R amendments to 312 this morning. Senator Schmit made a motion which would have removed the Goodrich amendments that had been amended, I believe, earlier by Senator Carpenter. That motion failed even after Senator Carpenter objected to the withdrawal of the motion. It was eventually withdrawn. The bill was unchanged. Then, Senator Carpenter made the motion that he just made. That motion failed. The bill is still unchanged from where it was, I believe, yesterday is apparently what happened. Now, or at least some previous time to my being in the chair. So, the bill is now unchanged as it was decided the other day. We made no changes in it today. It's still in its pristine form as of when it was, at least, advanced to Select File except for the E & R amendments which the chair's understanding of those are that they are ordinary and rather routine amendments. So, now we are ready and have advanced the bill on from Select File. Do you have any further question?

SENATOR DICKINSON: Yes, you haven't answered my question. I am not sure that everybody understands what the E & R amendments say and we haven't had time or perhaps haven't taken time to insert them word for word into the bill. Now, I will ask a simple question of Senator..or anyone who wants to answer it. What..where now can these two detached facilities be placed. Just answer me this in very simple language.

PRESIDENT: Stand by. Just a minute. The E & R amendments, Senator Dickinson, would, of course, appear in the Journal and its the chair's understanding that they would be printed in there from a previous...excuse me, from a previous session.

CLERK: E & R amendments are found on Page 1486 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR DICKINSON: OK.

PRESIDENT: OK.

CLERK: Don't make any change in the bill. They simply polish out the amendments previously adopted.

PRESIDENT: They make no change in the bill.

SENATOR DICKINSON: There is no change in the original bill?
