SENATOR CARPENTER: This body is confronted with a problem that is very difficult to handle. I had a bill on abortion which is not in this bill but it relates to the same thing. It drove me crazy. There is just two kinds of bills I'll never introduce again, one is the abortion bill and one is the brand bill. I got experience on both of them. Now, we are all getting a lot of mail and this was noticed on the Board that this would be up yesterday and carried over today. Now, I don't want to do anything to prelude Senator Lewis from having his day in court and the only difference would be, it will take 25 votes in Select File and only a majority on General File for his amendment and other amendments. So, I would like to move that we advance the bill from General File to Select File. At that particular time, those two amendments and others could be heard at that particular time and then the body with 25 votes, of course, could amend it or whatever they want to do beyond that. I think it is important. I presume that this amendment, this Resolution has been written, probably, by those who are more directly involved than other people. Now speaking only for myself, I am willing to give them my support in this for whatever it is worth but I think we ought to let the rest of the laws like they are and I think this is a problem the Supreme Court of the
