them and to adopt the Anderson amendments to achieve the two purposes which have been engineered into the bill. One to impose restrictions, two to get into court and offer the court--Supreme Court a chance to alter their original decision.

I, I presume that actually still before the body is the Stahmer amendment and the Chair would propose that for a way of order, that we have Senator Anderson's explanation of his amendment, Senator Stahmer's amendment and then we'll vote on the issues separately unless there is some strong opposition from the floor
