PRESIDENT: Alright, we have before the house now Senator Goodrich's amendment to the Schmit's amendment and we're talking about the first half of his amendment which, of course, if the overlapping part the Chair understands, to Senator Schmit's amendment but I think, in order to clear this up, if it's agreeable with Senator Goodrich and with Senator Luedtke here, fine then, if we can add the non profit I'll take that as an amendment to his first half.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Fine, fine.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: If Senator Goodrich would just agree that his amendment inserts "non profit" before "organization," in those two places where the word "organization" appears, that's all we need to do and I don't have to make that motion.

SENATOR GOODRICH: That's fine.

PRESIDENT: Fine. Alright, now we have that then with non profit--

SENATOR GOODRICH: --non p--any non profit organization holding a liquor license.

PRESIDENT: Very good and it also appears in the next sentence then, it would be also in the management or administration of the non profit organization.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Right.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Are we agreed on that? If we are, then that's the motion now before the house. Do you all understand that particular motion? Is there a need for further discussion of that? Senator Schmit, I'm trying to smooth out the differences here between your amendment and Senator Goodrich's amendment. We have the first half of his amendment. We're dividing the question. Now then, do you want that read so you'll understand what that is?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I believe I understand it, Mr. President. If it's alright with Senator Chambers, it's alright with me. Then it's alright with me.

PRESIDENT: Alright then, question is shall the first half of the Goodrich amendment as has been explained then, be adopted? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Still needs 25 votes on select file. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, 22 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Now the first half of the Goodrich amendment then is now adopted to the Schmit amendment. Now, we'll take the second half because we've divided the question. Back to you Senator Goodrich on the second half then of your amendment.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Alright now I move the adoption of the second half of my amendment and that says; any law enforcement officer may stock in any organization; now let's make that non profit organization again, wait a minute, we can't do it here because this would be a profit organization.
