

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I just wonder if Senator Goodrich would be interested in delaying this bill until next..first of February. There is some things I'd like to support in it and some I'd like to kill but I just don't understand why we've wasted two hours on something here that has to do with a set of stock that I might own one share in a company which has a liquor license and I am not a policeman in that area.

PRESIDENT: Well, Senator Goodrich, do you care to respond to the question?

SENATOR GOODRICH: I think the question may be better directed to Senator Chambers than myself. I have no objection one way or the other.

PRESIDENT: We have the motion before us to indefinitely postpone. The question is shall LB 315 be indefinitely postponed. All those in favor will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. The motion is to indefinitely postpone LB 315. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 1 aye, 25 nays, 23 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion to indefinitely postpone is lost. We now have...do we have any other amendments now to 315. All right. Senator Cavanaugh, back to you then regarding LB 315 on Select File.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 315 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. The ayes have it. So ordered. The bill as amended is advanced. Back to you. 209.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: 299. Is that 99? 299. Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 299.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 299. All those in favor of the motion, please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 299 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance the bill. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 485.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendments to 485. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are amendments by Senator Cavanaugh-read.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Cavanaugh for the amendments.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Yes, I think that's a clarification of Senator Carpenter's bill. He expressed his only desire was to have the immunity extended during the course of Committee Hearings and I think that the language would
