CLERK: Now Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to unbracket LB 228A.

PRESIDENT: 228A? All right. Who's motion is that? Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, this is the other half of the 228 and 162 which we just handled. The matter relating to salaries of court reporters. Now all is under 162 so we have to take out any reference to court reporters in 228A and that's what the amendment does.

PRESIDENT: Now is there any further discussion then of the amendment? Well, first of all Senator Luedtke is asking unanimous consent to unbracket 228A. Are there objections to unbracketing the bill? Hearing none, so ordered. The bill is unbracketed. His motion now is to return 228A to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor, is there need for discussion? All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The motion is to return LB 228A to Select File for a specific amendment. Motion is to return 228A and that still does take 25 votes. Senator Luedtke is asking for Call of the House. Thank you. Motion is withdrawn. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT: Okay, 228A now is on Select File. Now what is your pleasure, gentlemen?

CLERK: That's all the motions then. Now Mr. President, going back to 162A. We would now be on Select File and the motion is to adopt the specific amendment

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendments which I've previously explained.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion now of the Waldron amendments to 162A? Question is, shall the Waldron amendments to 162A be adopted on Select File? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Motion is to adopt the Waldron amendments to 162A on Select File. That still requires 25 votes in this body. Adopting the Waldron amendments here to 162A on Select File. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays, 23 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Amendments are adopted. Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Okay, I'll move to advance 162 to E & R Final.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion now to re-advance, yes, to re-advance 162A to Final E & R as amended. All those in favor of re-advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So Ordered, the bill as amended is re-advanced.

CLERK: All right now, Mr. President, we have a motion to adopt the specific amendment to LB 228A. Signed, Senator Luedtke.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move to adopt the amendments on 228A which are to take out the money and put it in which we've already got in 162 so we'd better take it out of 228 now.

PRESIDENT: All right, now do you need to discuss that motion? Question is, shall the amendment be adopted? All those in favor
