I wonder if everyone understands what happened here because I did call the Chair and ask the question if the title of the bill and the bill itself conformed with each other and I'm informed that it does because in this particular bill, we're fixing it so that traffic violations cannot have a jury trial. Is that correct?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Yes.

SENATOR DUIS: Yes, in other words, then you have to be sure and see that word except in there.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: That's correct.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: You are absolutely correct.
