SENATOR WHITNEY: Well, this just seemed to be the best policy to follow--

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well, I don't agree--

SENATOR CARPENTER: I don't, I don't agree with the-- because the Governor says we are irresponsible and by his appointments, these two and by the withdrawal of Gus Lieske, he shows he's entirely irresponsible. SENATOR CARPENTER: Well, I think we ought to report it out here and discuss the irresponsibility of the recommendation to this body. People are completely irresponsible, if that's what your committee determined.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Senator Carpenter, I, your point is well taken by the Chairman of the Committee on Committees. I shall take your objection up with the Committee on Committees.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Thank you sir.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Now I'd like--

SPEAKER: Further--any further discussion on the point. Now the point is whether these nominees are going to be confirmed or not and I think we're getting a little off the track. Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President, point of personal privilege.

SPEAKER: Yes.

SENATOR NORE: I, I would, I would also suggest that before we take this drastic action in rejecting especially the man from Omaha, I think we should have a full, the full committee should be there. That, that is, I don't think that has been true. Just a part of the committee were there. I think the whole committee should be there when they vote, take that kind of action.
