PRESIDENT: Well, we already have a motion to adjourn. Do you want to move the previous question? All right the previous question has been moved, does the chair see 5 hands? Question is, shall the debate now close? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Previous question has been moved. All right, Clerk will record. Senator Savage now may close on his motion. Senator Savage may close on his motion here.

SENATOR SAVAGE: There was a motion made to adjourn.

PRESIDENT: All right, is there any other business to come before the body? Well, I think we ought to dispose of the motion here and we're going to adjourn here in a minute. The question is, shall 149 be bracketed? Senator Kremer, do you have a comment on the order?

SENATOR KREMER: Are you going to vote on the motion, I would hope we go ahead and vote it down and dispose of this issue now.

PRESIDENT: Yeah, we're going to take care of the motion to bracket. Question is, shall LB 149 be bracketed on General File at this time? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 4 ayes, 28 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion to bracket is lost. Back to you, Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I renew my motion to advance 149 to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Now the motion is to advance LB 149. Are you all through discussing the bill? Question is, shall 149 as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Clerk will record. I'm sorry, Senator Schmit.

CLERK: 32 ayes, no nays, 17 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Very good. 149 as amended is advanced. Do we have other business on the desk? Read the reports.

CLERK: Reads reports.

PRESIDENT: Is there any other business to come before the body? Motion is to adjourn then until 9:00 tomorrow morning. All those in favor of the motion signify by saying aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the ayes have it and we're adjourned until 9:00 tomorrow morning.
