which receives its principal revenue from a source other than the sale of alcoholic beverages. Such officers shall not participate in any manner in the management or administration of the organization. I move the adoption of this amendment. I move we bring the bill back for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Chambers, then Senator Whitney.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, LB 315 has been tortured and attempts have been made to mutilate it and this amendment was voted on yesterday. There was certain representations made by Mr. Goodrich at an earlier time which I feel he has not lived up to. He is not in favor of the bill. He tried to kill it and I don't see any point in bringing this bill back for this purpose and I ask you not to return the bill but to let it proceed as it has been going.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I sat down with Senator Goodrich and wrote this up and I tried to write it in such a way that it would meet with the approval of this Legislative body and I am quite certain that it does. The Budget Committee, nine members strong were out of this Legislative session the day this bill came up. Had I been here, this bill would have had this amendment on it because I would have voted in favor of it. I intend to vote for the bill at the end when it goes on Final Reading. This amendment was the one that I had thought Senator Chambers has agreed to when we first passed it from General File to Select File and I feel that this should be brought back for this specific amendment. Now just because the Budget Committee was out all afternoon up until 6:15 at night trying to get the building construction budget taking care of was the only reason why this amendment is not on here.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh, did you wish to be heard on the issue?

SENATOR MARSH: I have a question to ask Senator Goodrich, please.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich, will you yield?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Goodrich, does this mean you will support 315 on Final Reading if this amendment is adopted?

SENATOR GOODRICH: I answered that question the other day.

SENATOR MARSH: I am sorry. I may have not been here.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Let me finish. I answered that question the other day and I am not at all enthused about this bill. I have never said that I would support the bill but I am trying to get it in a proper form as possible if it is going to pass. Let's, at least, get it in the form that the Police Department, both county, city, and state police officers can live with. I have never said that I supported the bill. I am just trying to straighten it out so that we are not treating police officers as second class citizens and that we are trying to get the bill in a form that it can..they can live with it, if we actually pass the bill.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? All right. Then, Senator Goodrich, you may close on your motion on 315 on E & R bringing it back to Select File for specific amendment. Senator Goodrich is closing.
