SENATOR BARNETT: That's right.

PRESIDENT: All right, are there any objections? Senator Duis, do you object? Hearing no objections then, so ordered. We'll bracket the two bills on General File then. Now Senator Duis, do you have other business here?

SENATOR DUIS: Yes, Mr. President, I wanted to alert the Legislature that we do have a committee that functions during the interim and all during the session of administrative rules and regulations. We have a bill up there, LB 134 which we have considerable amendments up there which would I believe put this in shape so there would be no fiscal impact regarding it but would begin to put the rules and regulations of administrative departments in some type of order so we can work through this summer and I just wanted to alert you to the fact and especially Senator Warner, I mean Senator--what's your name?--Waldron that we're going to attempt to do this if you don't mind, Mr. President, within the next day or two so this committee will be able to function during the interim and I would now request please sir that the legislative bill 134 be put up on General File for the 17th, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis asking unanimous consent to slide 134 to the top of General File for discussion May 17. Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered then. We'll put it up there. Senator Whitney, do you have a communication there?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Yes, I just wanted to announce that the Committee on Committees, the majority of them, have asked for a meeting and we will meet immediately after the adjournment of this session in Room 2102.

PRESIDENT: Now stand by just a minute here. We may have lost the motion here or something today. May have lost more than that. Any other business to come before the body? Senator Syas, do you have any complaints?

CLERK: We have a motion to adjourn from Senator Syas.

PRESIDENT: All right, motion is to adjourn until 9:00 tomorrow morning. All those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. The ayes have it. So ordered, we're adjourned until 9:00 tomorrow morning.
