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will have to sacrifice and get here for it.

PRESIDENT: Alright, lets go back to Senator Stahmer, Senator Keyes and then Senator Marvel.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, and members of the body Senator Burbach raised a very interesting point that the original plan usggested by Speaker Proud allowed for 5 days on general file where as the two plans on the sheet with the right and left column a only allow for 3 days for bills on General File. I would think that under Senator Proud's original plan that the 5 days would allow us probably to hear the bills that are important up there where the other two columns will not. I think that is highly important and I think that we should give some some thought to this.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. President, fellow members we spent one hour and twenty-two minutes yesterday working on an adgenda that we seem to be 26 minutes working on the adgenda again today. If we would go to work on General File and just work half as hard as we work on the adgenda we would be off of the thing.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I would simply like to make this statement that there are 6 bills on General File that need to be considered before we adjourn. We talked about this briefly yesterday and I'll bring it up once more then I won't say any more about it. 581, 582, and 583 are the latest Governor's budget bills requesting supplemental deficiency appropriations. 256 is the Capital Construction Budget. 505 has to do with sewage disposal which is a deficiency bill and 579 has to do with the reappropriation of unexpended balances in the for the capital construction funds. I am prepared to discuss these at any time. You will receive a sheet hopefully by this afternoon that you can look over between now and when you meet again. If you are going to meet Monday, I would like to take these 6 up Tuesday and if you are going to be off Monday and Tuesday I would like to take them up by Wednesday if possible. That is about all that I can say at the moment. Some of these could be taken up even today as far as that is concerned, but in fairness to the Legislature and most of these they ought to wait until the first of the week. So in making up any schedule and voting on any schedule I hope that you will keep in mind these 6 bills that should be considered before we adjourn.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas and then Senator Burbach and then Senator Nore.

SENATOR SYAS: Alright Senators I think that we should settle this thing. Now to Senator Stahmer, we have to...I don't care what chart we come up with in this Legislature if we don't do it according to Emery Burnette he knows what the last day is that we can take up General File. If anyone wants to say our plan is better than our bill drafter, than our E & R committee clerk, he knows what is humanly possible to do and he set a specific date. The date is the one that he can comply with. The one that we might want he can not comply with, therefore I hope that Senator Burbach will make a motion to adopt his chart. Then when he does that I'm going to make a motion that those that want the right hand side column vote red and those that want the left hand side of the sheet vote green and we will settle it. But I think that Senator Burbach should make a motion that we could vote on the two alternate plans.
