SENATOR STULL: Mr. Chairman, members of the legislature, I move the E & R amendments to 542.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to 542. All those in favor of the motion say Aye, those opposed say No. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR STULL: Now I move 542 to E & R Engrossing as amended.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance 542 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say Aye, those opposed say No. So ordered, the bill is advanced.

SENATOR STULL: I move the E & R amendments to 358.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendment to 358. All those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say No. So ordered, we adopted the amendments to 358. Stand by just a minute.

CLERK: We have a request to bracket 358, signed Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Alright we have adopted the E & R amendments to it and now the motion is to bracket 358 on Select File. Are there objections to bracketing 358? Senator Fellman, do you object?

SENATOR FELLMAN: I object.

PRESIDENT: Alright Senator Warner make your motion then.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I didn't get a chance to tell Senator Fellman before I put it up. There is some questions in the minds of those who are interested in the original bill as to whether or not the amendments Senator Fellman that you put on the other day create a problem with the court case that was pending and the reason for the bracket is to give a little time and make a decision if there is or is not.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Will you yield to a question? Are you aware that there is a severability clause now on there?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes. But the confidence in the severability clause is not that great I don't think.

SENATOR FELLMAN: No greater than the question as to whether there is relevance to each other.

SENATOR WARNER: I was asking for a day or two at least.

SENATOR FELLMAN: A day, OK, could you bracket it for tomorrow, for Monday?

SENATOR WARNER: That is fine.

SENATOR FELLMAN: No objections.

PRESIDENT: Ok, then the motion is to bracket it until Monday Senator Warner?

SENATOR WARNER: That is fine.

PRESIDENT: OK, so ordered, LB358 is bracketed until Monday.
