SENATOR DUIS: We are still on General File sir, and General File does not require 25 votes does it?

PRESIDENT: It does for reconsideration of a motion.

SENATOR DUIS: We are not going to reconsider the motion sir, I suggest that the amendments be adopted and then have then that would then be the bill then a have amendments to it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, members of the legislature, Senator Keyes has withdrawn his objection, and if nobody else objects I so move that the Warner amendment be amended.

PRESIDENT: Alright we have Senator Maresh's amendment. All those in favor of Senator Maresh's amendment to Senator Warner amendment to 472 please say aye, those opposed say....read the amendment, this is Senator Maresh's amendment.

CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Have you adopted....oh you haven't voted yet, excuse me.

PRESIDENT: No, we haven't voted. Senator Warner, do you want to discuss the Maresh amendment?

SENATOR WARNER: No I was just going to suggest, I think that Senator Duis' motion is proper but I have no objection to accepting Senator Maresh's amendment at this point, but then from then on if we could adopt the amendment that I offered and then work from that I think that it would be more orderly.

PRESIDENT: Well the Chair has accepted the Senator Maresh motion and I think that I'm in the position now that I will have to rule that we are going to vote on the Maresh amendment then we will take the Warner amendment and then we will go from there and then if you want to amend that fine, that is the way that we will go. All those in favor of the Maresh amendment please say aye, those opposed say no. Ayes have it so ordered. The Maresh amendment is adopted. We are back to Senator Warner's amendment. Is there any further discussion of Senator Warnoer's amendment? I have several lights on, Senator Duis has spoken, Senator Frank Lewis do you want to be heard on Senator....excuse me, Senator Duis do you want back on here.

SENATOR DUIS: I beg your pardon, my light was on for a question of Senator Warner on his amendment.

PRESIDENT: Go ahead sir.

SENATOR DUIS: If I might just two quick questions. The effective date of your act has been changed so that it dove tails with 172, is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: As the amendment is right now Senator Duis, the effective date for rate change is January 1, 1975. I have the amendment on the desk to change that to January of 1974.
