

PRESIDENT: Amendment is adopted. Do we have other amendments now to the bill?

CLERK: There are none on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright, I still have some lights on. Senator Keyes, for what purpose do you wish to be recognized.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. President I did want to speak on the amendment which is already a passed. I realize that this is a very slick pass of Senator Carpenter and the other Senators that agree with him and today we are going to a talk on some of these bills and we are going to allow the opposition to talk or we are going to stop this legislation. Now right now. I have had my light up and Senator Carpenter pulled the old trick to manoeuvre. I'm going to talk for this bill before it is over with. But Senator Carpenter pulled the old trick to shut down legislation when one side had had their side and nobody on the opposition had had time to talk. Mr. President, I'm going to support this bill. State aid to education has two or three things that it must accomplish in this state first of all this bill puts until this last amendment went on, 60% of the money that is raised by the sales and income tax into foundation and that helps every student in every school district across the state. Now the part that was going to equalize and make certain that the mil levy was the same and try to equalize the mil levy over the state a contained 40%. Of course this does not meet with me because I have some school districts that 40% on equalization certainly does not equalize the mil levy and the obligation of the people to provide education. This is one bill, if we pass it right now and do not offer any more amendments to it, I will support it, but if you offer any more amendments that puts more money into foundation, you are going to loose and you are going to loose this bill. You can't get it passed. It is amazing that this is the way that this legislation went. We should have had a very good explanation on this bill. We should have had an explanation of what this last amendment of Senator Burbach's did but we didn't get it, they couldn't give you nothing of what it did, so I'm going to ask that you just put debate on this thing right now and lets vote on it. I'm asking for the question.

PRESIDENT: Well Senator Keyes, I'm sorry but I'm going to rule your motion out of order for....

SENATOR KEYES: Alright Senator I would like to ask you why your going to rule it out of order. You didn't rule Senator Carpenter out of order.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes if you will relinquish the mike and the floor so that I don't have to shut the mike off I will be glad to tell you. The reason for that is that the motion has not been made to advance the bill. As soon as that motion is made then whatever you care to do or whatever motion you care to make after that will be in order. But until I have that motion I can't except your motion at this time. Now does somebody want to make a motion on 472 as amended. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would move that 472 be advanced to E & R and I assume that there are some.....

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance LB472. Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: Well there are some people that want to talk on the bill and I think that we should have this right. I
