SPEAKER: Record your presence.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Fred Carstens asked to be excused this PM.

SPEAKER: Any objections? No objection, so ordered.

CLERK: Read

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? OK the clerk will record the votes.

SPEAKER: Alright other announcements on the Clerks desk.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Are there committee amendments?

CLERK: No committee amendments, they are all E & R amendments.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I mean E & R amendments.

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Let me explain that this is only a matter of expediting the business in order to get as many off of Select File as we can and get them over on Final Reading. So are we starting with, whats the number?

CLERK: 172.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that.....

SPEAKER: Excuse me, just a minute. The request for unanimous consent to revert to Select File for the purpose of considering amendments to bills on Select File. Are there any objections? OK, so ordered.
