SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Stahmer, then Senator Maresh, Senator Warner and Senator Mahoney. Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Senator Whitney if you would I would like to ask you a question about this amendment please.

SPEAKER: Senator Whitney, do you yield?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Yes

SENATOR STAHMER: Senator Whitney, I'm not clear about your amendment but I would like to ask some questions about it. You start out by saying that the amount provided by section four of this act for allocation under this section, namely section nine. To begin with I don't see any place under section four that any money is appropriated under section 9 would you please explain that if you could.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Senator Stahmer, I asked the bill writer to put this up, and I think that we have, I think that he amended the original bill, at least our bill writer knows exactly what he is doing because he explained it. I explained it to him and he wrote it up. Where he puts it in the bill I think that is the bill writers problem and I don't think it is the problem here. I think that we are looking at two different places from what he says.

SENATOR STAHMER: Senator Whitney, maybe I am making a mistake, but I am looking at the original bill. Maybe if I were not looking at the original but at the amendments perhaps it would reflect differently but you are stating here the amount provided by section four of this act by allocation of a...a-.under this section and under the original bill there is no provision under section four for any allocation to section nine. You mention the figure eight million dollars. The only reference to money that I see under section four has to do with five million for section seven. Number one I can't understand your amendment mathematically.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Then it would be in section four, the amendment then if that is what it says. You see you are already having five million dollars set aside for allocation by state board of education by provisions of section eight and then a 55 million 200 thousand for other specific situations and this would follow right in there then Senator Stahmer. Meaning then that this amount would then be set aside for that purpose.

SENATOR STAHMER: Senator Whitney I'm not sure that I understand your amendments, so I can't speak either for or against, I just don't see unless you can specifically show where section 4 that you are referring to deals with section nine and you are talking about dispersal according, I don't see to me unless you can explain where in the amendment or in the original bill the moneys are so designated that I don't don't see where it is applicable.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Senator Stahmer, will you please wait and then I will have the bill writer come to me and explain to me why he did it this way, and where he put it.

SENATOR STAHMER: Be happy to wait.
