

fifteen is stricken by the amendment. Section sixteen is the filing of the expenses and the receipts and the fact that they are open to the public. The section now from this point on Mr. President, I would like to suggest that the amendments as they are on the Clerk's desk through those covering section sixteen be adopted and then the balance of the amendment affecting seventeen I would like to take one at a time. Because they are far more controversial.

PRESIDENT: Alright then it is the Chair's understanding that we are going to discuss the Warner's amendments which affect this bill through section sixteen. Correct Senator Warner?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, at this point.

PRESIDENT: At this point that is correct. Alright, do we have discussion on the amendments to the Warner amendment to 267 now through section 16? Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: I just have a question of Senator Warner. Who requested this legislation and why?

SENATOR WARNER: As I indicated again Senator I was working on my own last summer and during the course of acquired information I went to the Secretary of State's office as a Chief election officer, I found that they had been doing some accumulating of information from various states as to the campaign practices act of those states and they accumulated the information for me which I then chose which part of these various states that are in this bill.

SEANTOR PROUD: I don't know whether I am for it or against it but how is this supposed to benefit the public?

SENATOR WARNER: I think the benefit of the public is the fact that this should provide full disclosure of contributions as well as expenses made by a candidates. I should point out that the present limitations which you do not have to report by name, contribution, is over a hundred dollars is retained. But contributions...excuse me, contributions under a hundred dollars do not need to be recorded by name only by total amount and those above as is the law now by name from the source.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer did you wish to be recognized? Would you turn your light off then please? It is terribly difficult to keep track of who is doing what here. Now is there any further discussion of the Warner amendments through section 16? Any further discussion?
