CLERK: Senator Carpenter changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter is changing from no to yes. Senator Duis, changing from aye to no. No, no to yes, Senator Duis changing from no to yes. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: This is on 44--

PRESIDENT: 445A. Senator Chambers votes aye.

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. Chairman, I want to at the proper time, move to bracket 235---

PRESIDENT: Hold off, we'll vote here. I'm sorry. I thought you had something pertaining to this particular issue at this time. Stand by. Senator Stull changing from no to aye.

CLERK: Senator Stull changing from no to aye. 30 ayes, 14 nays, and 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. We'll proceed with the final reading of LB 445.

CLERK: Legislative bill #445, introduced by Senator Frank Lewis of the 45th district (read)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record. Senator Duis, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DUIS: Voting aye,

CLERK: Roll call vote read. 32 ayes, 9 nays, 8 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause, attached.
