

for the same commission. There is nothing in here but reappropriation of unexpended balances for those projects that are, have already been approved by the legislature, are in the midst of construction, but have not been completed. If you don't approve of this bill, then what you need is, well you will leave these projects in the middle of construction. Now if you have some specific question on the projects then if you will let me know, I'll try to get you the answer, because I have got to get a staff member too up here. Does anybody have any specific questions that I need to get additional information on.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well now this bill has new projects in it or not?

SENATOR MARVEL: No sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: There is no new project in there at all.

SENATOR MARVEL: It is my understanding that there is no new projects in here. No sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: On page 12, there is a building here for Kearney State College, 1million, 800 thousand. When was that authorized?

SENATOR MARVEL: That was authorized last session.

SENATOR CARPENTER: And you are only appropriating the money for it now.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: And that includes everything else in here?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir, and the million 809 was, was appropriated, and that building was not built.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Are these projects even in progress or about to be put in progress.

SENATOR MARVEL: One or the other, yes sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Ok. Now I would presume that when these bills got on the select file, that they be subject to amendment under the normal rules.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: They could all be discussed on their merit then.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of 579. Does anyone have any questions of Senator Marvel? All right, then the question is, shall LB 579 be advanced from general file to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those oppsed vote no. You are voting on the advancement of 579 and the chair would again ask if you have all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, no nays, 15 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That brings up general file debate of LB 581.

CLERK: Legislative bill 581, introduced by Richard F. Proud, speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read)
