PRESIDENT: Alright, the motion is to recess until 1:00. All those in favor of recessing until 1:00 please say aye. Those opposed say no. Ayes have it, so ordered, we're recessed.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. It's 1:01. Please record your presence. We're looking for a quorum. No fair punching anybody else's button. Have you all indicated your presence? Clerk will record.

CLERK: (mike off, inaudible)

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Pardon me, what, Senator Warner what--Senator Warner present, Senator Burbach present. Senator Kelly. Quorum is not present. Well, why don't you be at ease for a couple of minutes here, just be at ease. Now that's fine. We're going to still be at ease a couple minutes. (mike off)--call. Please indicate your presence again. Roll call. Thank you, Sergeant at Arms. Once again, have you all indicated your presence? Clerk will record. Quorum present.

CLERK: A quorum is present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Do we have any not--

CLERK: Unanimous consent asked to be excused.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered. Senator Duis, for what purpose do you want to be recognized?

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I started making a motion this morning for the reconsideration of LB 445 because of the fact the emergency clause wasn't on it. I think that I was construed as having withdrew my motion. I renew that motion for reconsideration for tomorrow morning so that this bill will not be sent over to the Governor's office because I've just come back from the Attorney General's office and I am sure from the conversation I had with him that we better have the emergency clause on this bill so that it will be effective on July 1, 1973.

PRESIDENT: Very good. The Chair was aware--Senator Duis, the Chair was aware that you had just set that off but I appreciate your letting the body know that at this point for clarification. Do we have any notices of--yes, we have the notices of committee hearings?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Are there any reports?

CLERK: Just one motion, Mr. President, unanimous consent to consider LB 587 close to the top of general file today. Signed Senator Carpenter.
