

PRESIDENT: Now wait minute, does the chair hear another amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: Can I amend his amendment?

PRESIDENT: Yep. I can take two, and your is the second one then.

SENATOR CLARK: I want \$60,000 to operate the board in Western area that has no board operating at the present time because they have no money to operate a board. Any more than eastern has.

PRESIDENT: Well, the Carpenter amendment was western. Or are you talking about another one now?

SENATOR CLARK: I'm talking about another one for the board. That is what he is talking about and actually 259 is predicated upon 7 districts. It is going to have to be determined in 533 as to how we are going to go at all. With it's 7 or 8 or whatever it is going to be.

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark, does the chair understand that is another 60,000.

SENATOR CLARK: 60,000.

PRESIDENT: All right. Now we have an amendment to an amendment to the original motion. Now, Senator Stahmer, we're speaking now on the Clark amendment. Your passing. Anybody else want to speak on the Clark amendment. Senator Dickinson. Ok. Senator Frank Lewis. All we have is the Clark amendment now.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. chairman, may I ask a question of Senator Warner, a, Marvel please.

PRESIDENT: Sure, Senator Marvel, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

SENATOR LEWIS: Senator Marvel, has it been traditional that when Voc-Tec school started that we gave seed money.

SENATOR MARVEL: I'm trying to,

SENATOR LEWIS: Somewhere in my memory I think Mid-Plains for instance received seed money if I remember correctly.

SENATOR MARVEL: You mean to start before they actually had a school?

SENATOR LEWIS: I can't honestly answer your question. When we first started, when I first came in here, we had two State wide Voc-Tec schools. One at Milford, no we had one to start with. Milford, and then we added Sidney. I assume we did, but I can't honestly say yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, do you have a further question?

SENATOR LEWIS: No, if anybody else on the budget committee could answer that question, if the precedent has been previously set, I would appreciate the response to that.

PRESIDENT: Well, no response. Let's go back. Senator Dickinson back to you. You asked for the floor a minute ago. What is--

SENATOR DICKINSON: Mr. President, a question of the chair perhaps, please.
