SENATOR CARPENTER: Pending on 582, I'd like to discuss it. It has nothing to do with money.

PRESIDENT: Let's take the other amendment then to 582. Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter. Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BARNETT: Just a question of the chair. I don't know if you stated it intentionally or whether I misunderstood it back here with Senator Proud. But you said we would hold 582 until 533 is discussed and I understood Senator Duis to say that we would pass 582 on and add these amendments on select. I do have a question of the chair how you ruled on that.

PRESIDENT: Well, I may have confused you, but it was my understanding you see Senator Kremer, had asked unanimous consent to bypass. I heard no other motions or I heard no modifications of that. Let's go back. Senator Duis are you in the chamber?

SENATOR BARNETT: I think Senator Duis said to pass it on, get its on its way, and we would add these amendments after we have heard 533 and then we would add them on select file.

PRESIDENT: Well it was the chairs understand that he meant just to pass over it, or pass on to the next bill at this particular time and we may have gotten into semantics here. He isn't here to confirm it. Senator Marvel,

SENATOR MARVEL: I think Senator Carpenter has an amendment that does not to 582, that does not have to do with money. If he would be allowed to discuss this and adopt that, then I think the, as Senator Barnett rightly heard and I would try to advance the bill with his amendment on and then hold it on select file.

PRESIDENT: Right, now wait a minute.

SENATOR MARVEL: So I would ask unanimous consent if we don't confuse the issue to have Senator Carpenter have his amendment to 582 considered.

PRESIDENT: That is fine with the chair, but the chair doesn't understand what you want to do with the Carpenter amendment, which was amended by Senator Proud. Do you just want to hold that amendment to add it to when we get on select file?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir. Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: Your holding that amendment in advance, but not the bill right?

SENATOR MARVEL: Thank-you. Boy, the chair understands. Thank-you Senator Barnett, I appreciate that. We did get into a thicket. Now back to Senator Carpenter then for his amendment to
