PRESIDENT: Just want to hold that amendment to add it to when we get on Select File.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: You are holding that amendment in advance but not the bill. Right?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Boy, the chair understands. Senator Barnett, thank you. I appreciate that. We did get into a thicket. Now back to Senator Carpenter, then, for his amendment to 582.

CLERK: Would you like it read, Senator.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Certainly.

PRESIDENT: The clerk will read the bill.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Read it slow.

CLERK: OK. The amendment reads: Read.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter, before you start, I need a motion from Senator Kremer to withdraw his unanimous consent motion to hold 533. Senator Kremer, do you withdraw your motion on 533? All right. So ordered. Are there objections to the withdrawal of that motion. Ok. That's out of the way. Now back to Senator Carpenter with his motion.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Now, I move the adoption of the amendment. What this does, it says that the..that the government of the state of Nebraska cannot obligate itself for an amount or amounts above fifty thousand dollars in individual operations without the appropriation being made by this body. That's the purpose of it and refers directly to, basically to computers. We feel, at least I feel, that if and when we have a new policy on computers, it ought to go through the regular process of coming to this body for an appropriation in order to accomplish the desired results. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Now, is there a discussion of this Carpenter amendment. Senator Nore, do you wish to be heard on this amendment? Thank you. The question is shall the Carpenter amendment be adopted. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, that amendment is adopted. Back to you, Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move that 582 as amended be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there need for further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB 582 as amended now be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of LB 582 from General File to E & R Initial with the understanding that the Carpenter amendment, the Proud amendment and the Clark amendment will be heard later on, then, on Select File. Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes. 0 nays, remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. This brings us up for General File debate, LB 256, then. Senator Luedtke's bill.

CLERK: Read title. LB 256. There are lengthy Committee amendments from Senator Marvel's Appropriations Committee.
