PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Waldron is asking...

SENATOR WALDRON: We'd appreciate if some of you would change your vote and you can vote against it on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: Senator Waldron is asking for a Call of the House. At the next bell, please indicate your support of a Call of the House. Motion is for a Call of the House. Once again, the chair would inquire, have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 9 nays, for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: All right. Now we are under a Call of the House. We are under aCall of the House and the chair could respectfully ask the Senators to take their seats. At the next bell, please indicate your presence. Senator Duis voting aye on the original motion.

CLERK: Senator Duis voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh voting no on the original motion.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting no.

PRESIDENT: We are under a Call of the House. The original motion..the motion under vote is the advancement of LB 256 from General File to E & R Initial. Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: How many are excused, Mr. President.
