SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I ask that this bill be held over and Senator Schmit has the amendment that I was waiting on and I don't know where he is. I was wondering if we could pass over this bill again on 562 and just leave it on Select File for a little longer until we locate Senator Schmit and then we can always take it up tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: All right, we'll hold it and we'll see if conditions change for you this morning, Senator Waldron, I think we'd like to move it on if we possibly can why don't you let me know.

SENATOR WALDRON: Okay, Senator Barnett says Senator Schmit's now on his way down to the chambers so he should be here directly.

PRESIDENT: All right. Let's go to 111 and see what happens there.

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 111 there are a series of amendments pending on the bill. There's a request to pass it over. By Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter's asking unanimous consent to pass over 111. Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered. Do we have any other motions to reconsider? Any motions to advance from committee?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Any other pending motions?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Any unfinished business?

CLERK: Lots of it.

PRESIDENT: Unfinished business? That's what we're coming to now are the consideration of bills on General File which are unfinished business. All right. General File debate this morning then begins with LB 256 followed by 563. Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Well, Mr. President, 256 was considered yesterday and amended and the bill failed to advance on a motion to advance and that's its present status. There are no further pending amendments.

PRESIDENT: We're looking at LB 256. Once again, the first order of business this morning. Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced to E & R for review. You might, Senator Burbach said he might have another amendment, I don't know whether he does or not. 256?

PRESIDENT: 256, General File debate.

SENATOR WALDRON: Then I move it be advanced to E & R for review.

PRESIDENT: Here we go, Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I believe the first motion would have to be some type of motion to bring it up from the bottom of General File. The bill having failed to advance...
