SENATOR STALLER: Mr. President, if I would, I'd like to ask unanimous consent to take up LB 403 which is a result of an interim study committee. I passed a note around to you earlier this morning. I have an amendment to offer now in lieu of the committee amendments that would take the expenditures out of it and would not require an A-bill this year. It would help correlate all the laws dealing with handicapped children, retarded, etc. as they pertain to the public schools. This has a great deal of support all over the state. It is not my bill, it's not for Omaha, it is for the state and it is for children. I think it is important that we put a whole year into this and I'd like to move that this bill be heard at this time, that the standing committee amendments be set aside and my amendments that would take out the fiscal cost for this year be adopted.
