SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 366.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt LB 366. All those in favor of that, please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 366 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance 366 as amended. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 267.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to 267. All those in favor of that motion say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, there are amendments offered by Senator Warner, to this bill. Amend Senator Warners amendment, adopted May 11, which struck original section 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, by reinstating original sections 22 and 26, signed Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner,

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendment. When I struck, what I said was the controversial amendment the other day, I intervertently struck these two sections, 22, and 26. These are existing laws, one deals, 22 deals with high corporate body, corporations can contribute and this should be reinstated to the present law entact. The other one prohibits a candidate from promising to help an alien become a naturalized citizen in return for a vote and this is an existing law and I didn't intend nor should either of those sections been stricken the other day. So I reglue their adoption.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Warner amendments? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Voting on the Warner amendments to 267 on select file. It still takes 25 votes.
