CLERK: None of these bills are covered by that..affect what we did yesterday. I have a motion from Senator Duis covering bills and none of these are in that group.

SENATOR CARPENTER: As I understand, we are going to consider all bills on Select File in that position.

CLERK: Oh, OK. I am sorry, then.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Senator Carpenter, I thought at the time the bills that went across normally with all the amendments we consider them as Select File. The ones when we started with the group that we just..I got a list of those bills. Those are the ones that we would consider as being on General File. The others would normally run across. They are the only ones they have back. The ones that we advanced yesterday are not back yet.

SENATOR CARPENTER: But there is nothing up there except the ones that will be up there.

SENATOR DUIS: Ya, they have some back now that we passed before we started this and I though we'd just go ahead with Select File on those normally.

SENATOR CARPENTER: 581, we (inaudible) yesterday.

SENATOR DUIS: But, I mean when we started with the group. I think we started with 562, when we started moving them across, and I just took those bills from then on down. Those bills before that that we took on General File have all the amendments and everything on them and they are ready to go across Select File as normal bills but the ones that we started with, I think, with Senator Burbach's 562 or something like that.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well, 581, I have some amendments and that was moved off of the file yesterday and I want to be able to attempt to amend that with a majority of the votes. Well, I move to amend this motion, any bill on Select File from now on be considered as if it were on General File and can be adopted or amended upon a majority of those voting.

SENATOR DUIS: Well the motion I have up there is for that but it requires 25 votes, then, to advance it from Enrollment and Review to Final Reading, so that it would be the same as General File.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I have no objection to that. I don't want to change that.

SENATOR DUIS: Well, I was just trying to make Select File for those bills that we advanced without amendment, you know, yesterday, so that they were treated the same as they were on General File.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well, I didn't understand anybody agreed not to attempt to amend any of these bills.

SENATOR DUIS: No, no. I didn't say that. I said they'd be treated over there the same as General File. In other words, a majority vote on amendments but 25 votes to advance.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Does your motion cover 557 down to 582.

SENATOR DUIS: I can't tell you. Vince had the list of those numbers. Those were passed ahead of the time that we
