SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 246.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments now to 246. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 246 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now the motion is to--excuse me, Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: (mike off)--Mr. President, I'd like to make a brief statement. When this bill was heard in the committee which I was a member of, we set a member of the committee to see the Governor of the State of Nebraska, ask him specific, did he want to recommend that his salary be raised beyond what it is to \$35,000 a year. He indicated as I understand, we were told, that really being specific, he didn't want to do it. Now the point I want to make, I don't want anyone to criticize this body for having his salary lower than other people of a less responsible position. His salary is maintained, for whatever reason at the present level, at his request. Now whether that will have anything to do with the predecessor in the future, I do not know. As of now, I would think the Governor of the State of--probably be reelected. That may not be so, but in any case it would affect not only him but those who otherwise might take his place so I want to call your attention now, if anybody wants to amend the bill insofar as raising his salary to \$35,000 which I would support but he was rather adamant about his position, I suggested to the committee we leave it like he wanted it. If there's no one wants to amend it, I move the bill be passed on.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? Question is, shall then 246 be advanced as amended to E&R for Engrossing? All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill is advanced.
