

starting 75 to 74 and there is numerous dates in the bill. There was one which was changed yesterday which should not have been. That is corrected. Then the other amendment is one which is additional wordage which has no impact. All it states is that the state department is required to transmit to each school district whatever information they need, which obviously they would do, but there will be no question of what it will be done and then the last amendment changes the sections which has to do with the repeal sections and as it developed from back from E & R yesterday, there was two sections dealing with repeal. There can, obviously, only be one and this is to correct that. I thought it could be done in E & R but Emory suggested it would be more proper to do that. This is all the amendments do and I would move that the bill return to Select File to adopt these amendments. There should be no more relative to correcting these kinds of things in the bill.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question. Any discussion? All right. The question is whether or not..whether LB 472 shall be returned to Select File for specific amendments. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. It requires 25 votes. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, 23 not voting on the motion to return.

SPEAKER: The bill is returned. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of those specific amendments.

SPEAKER: Any discussion. All those in favor of adopting the amendments vote aye. Those opposed vote no. It requires 25 votes. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, 22 not voting.

SPEAKER: They are adopted. Senator Warner, what will you do with the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I now move the bill be advanced..readvanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: All those in favor of readvancing the bill as amended say aye. Those opposed no. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, could I ask unanimous consent that it carry an expedite so that it can catch up to where..

SPEAKER: Any objections? So ordered, the bill is to be expedited and it is advanced. What's on the clerk's desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to return LB 583 to Select File for a specific amendment. Signed, Senator Marvel.

SPEAKER: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: LB 583 is a bill to add cash funds to the Health Department and the emergency clause was left off. All this does is to put the emergency clause on.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? All those in favor of returning this bill, 583, to Select File to add the emergency clause vote aye. Opposed vote no. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, 23 not voting on the motion to return.

SPEAKER: Now the motion is, I presume, to adopt the emergency clause, Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: That's right. I so move, Mr. President.
