CLERK: 29 ayes, no nays, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: Amendment is adopted. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move the bill be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye. Those opposed no. Bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a communication addressed from Burl Johnson (read) Mr. President, we then have pending Legislative Resolution 85 which was laid over from this morning.

SPEAKER: Whose resolution is it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Senator Carpenter's resolution and there are now amendments offered to it, also by Senator Carpenter which would substitute the amendment for the original resolution.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Is there another amendment to this resolution?

CLERK: Just your amendment, the one--

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President. During this morning, those who had amendments and I got together, I don't know how many else, I think it represents the University as well, and we've agreed to this resolution which takes the place of the pending resolution so I move for the adoption of the resolution.

SPEAKER: Well, I, I think we'll have to adopt the amendment, won't we, Mr. Clerk? Is that right? Senator, do you want to explain the amendment or what?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well the amendment only changes a minor part of the language. Senator Luedtke probably can explain it better than I am because it changes things he suggested which I concur in.

SPEAKER: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature. The only change is--comes about as a result of a question I asked Senator Carpenter when the resolution first was read to the Legislature and that was the question of how would these private funds that we would be donated be treated and what would they cover and would it be contingent upon the receipt of these funds before any such funds could be utilized in adding the kind of swimming pool they were setting forth the specifications for in this resolution so the way the amendment reads is that the--it's exactly the same introduction and the WHEREAS' are the same and then the first, the first four items on pages 1 and 2 under the number 1 part of the resolution is--includes those particular items which can be supplied right now under the interest funds under LB 510. There was, there was a memorandum of understanding that these would be covered by 510 and those will be covered. Now, any additional change in the construction of this swimming facility would have to come from private funds donated for the special field house facilities and, and then the rest of the items mentioned in
