CLERK: All right. The first one is 423 with amendments.

SENATOR STULL: John, do you want to take these?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: No, go ahead.

SENATOR STULL: I will. OK. I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to 423.

SPEAKER: All right. Is there any discussion.

UNIDENTIFIED: Question.

SPEAKER: All in favor of adopting the amendments say aye. Those opposed no.

SENATOR STULL: Move the bill as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Any discussion. I am assuming there is no discussion. There are a couple of lights on up here. Senator Stahmer's light is on and Senator Mahoney's. You don't want to talk on this. This is a motion to advance. Am I right Senator Stull. All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR STULL: Now, I move the E & R amendments to 557.

SPEAKER: Any discussion. All those in favor of adopting the amendments say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted. Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: I move that 557 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Any discussion. Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR STULL: Now I move the E & R amendments to 256 be adopted.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the amendments say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR STULL: Now I move that 256 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Motion is to advance the bill. Any discussion? All those in favor say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR STULL: Now, Mr. Chairman, I have no objection to getting Emory in here if they want him to make a statement.
