SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I request at this time to pull 172 back to Select File for specific amendment but I would wait to put that amendment on this afternoon, if I might.

PRESIDENT: Well, we have to have the amendment before we can vote to return it, anyway. Why don't you wait and take it up this afternoon.

SENATOR LEWIS: I was assuming that you might read the bill at this time and.....

PRESIDENT: No, No. This is for after recess. We are not going to take any more Final Reading this morning, Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Very good.

CLERK: Mr. President, we do have a motion to return LB 535 to Select File for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Duis.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I would like to hold that until this afternoon, also.

PRESIDENT: All right. We are trying to clear off the desk up here so we beau cou (sp.) business piled up.

CLERK: The only think left then, Mr. President, would be to advance the bills that were returned and I think some of those want to be held. We can advance those that were replaced. There is nothing else they can do on those.

PRESIDENT: OK. The chair does not have a list of those. I have the ones that are on Select File now but I don't know...All right, Senator Cavanaugh, apparently we can handle..well, let's see here. Senator Frank Lewis, your light is still on. Wait a minute. Would one of the Pages when you go past Senator Lewis' desk there, punch his white light off. That's terribly confusing when I've got things going on here. Senator Duis. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Yes, Mr. President, I think Select File we should take up those bills that are not on that list that I gave to you on the suspension of the Rules. Is that correct, Vince? Have you got those so you can handle them?

CLERK: I was just going to try to advance only those that had been replaced because there is nothing you can do on those anyway.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you. Very good. Thank you. That's very good...

PRESIDENT: ..we would not advance any others. Senator Cavanaugh, apparently we can advance 472, 562, 534, and 267. Does the chair understand there are no amendments to those.

CLERK: No, there is amendments to all of them.

PRESIDENT: Excuse me. There is no E & R amendments to them, either?

CLERK: There is amendments to all of them.

PRESIDENT: Excuse me. They were replaced for E & R amendments. So, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 472.
