CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays, on motion to return.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned. The chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Technically, on your desk Vince, the second part of this motion is to strike the standing committee amendments and add the emergency clause and this will have the effect of returning the amount of the original figure. So I so move.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? You all understand the motion? Question then is, shall the amendment be adopted to the bill? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed vote no. Voting on the adoption of the Marvel amendment to LB 505 on select file. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, 20 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move that the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Are you all through Senator Marvel. All right, the motion is to readvance LB 505 as amended. All those in favor of readvancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill as amended is readvanced. I only heard one no.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next one, I move to return LB 563 to select file for specific amendment, signed Senator Luedtke.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Luedtke. 563.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the first I have to move it back. Motion is to move it back so that we can add a specific amendment to 563. This is the, the bill on the removal of the department of corrections from the department of institutions and this particular section was caught by Emory Burnett when he was going through the for E & R, he found that, that line 8 through 18, on page 45, that this is old matter which should have been stricken. It is old matter which dealt with the old board of control as far, as getting rid of, the director of corrections or the wardens and that sort of thing and it no longer has any application. So the whole matter should be stricken. It is getting rid of al matter, so it would strike lines from the on line 8, right through line 18.
