PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel, do you care to respond.

SENATOR MARVEL: No, I agree, Senator Luedtke said everything I wanted to say. I'm opposed to bringing the bill back.

PRESIDENT: Ok. The motion is to return LB 256 to select file for specific amendment. Senator Maresh, do you care to close on your motion?

SENATOR MARESH: No, I just want to say that it was called to my attention by Eldin Ehrlich that it might be until 1978 before this reduction in the number of people at the school would come about, so that is several years off and I understand the superintendent there told me that a lot of these youngsters will not work out it in this program as planned. That they still will return to the youth development center.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The motion is, to return LB 256 to select file for specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Motion is, to return the bill. To return 256 to select file for specific amendment. Are you all through voting? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 11 nays, 10 nays, 28 not voting, Mr. President, on a motion to return.

PRESIDENT: The motion is lost. Are there other motions regarding bills for select file.

CLERK: None, none to return Mr. President. We have a request by Senator Waldron to withdraw LB 313. This was made yesterday and laid over to general file.

PRESIDENT: Good enough. Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I renew my request for unanimous consent to withdraw 313.
