SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I'd like to remind the members of the Legislature that immediately following the session today we're going to continue our discussion in the East Chamber on LB 587 with those people that are interested in, in the regulation of fuel distribution here in the State of Nebraska.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Important announcement. Then 5--select file will begin at 526 then?

CLERK: 472.

PRESIDENT: 472. Thank you. Back to you Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 472.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to adopt the amendments to 472. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 472 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 472. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered the bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 423.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to 423. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 423 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered the bill is advanced.

CLERK: Alright, Mr. President, 530 has E&R amendments but it has other amendments pending on it.

PRESIDENT: Alright, make the motion on the E&R amendments then.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 530.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E&R amendments to LB 530. All those in favor of that motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. E&R amendments are adopted. Do you want to lay this one over for the other amendment?

CLERK: There are amendments pending on it--

PRESIDENT: Alright, we'll lay over 530. We'll go on to 114 then?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 114.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to 114. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.
